

Q: How do I View Images of my Checks?

A: First you have to access the 'Transaction Activity' of the account you want to view checks for. There are 2 ways you can access your account information.

3. Indicated in **RED**, you can scroll down to the 'Deposits' or 'Loans' portions and click on the account number link of the account you would like to access.
4. Indicated in **BLUE** you can use the 'Accounts' link located in the left side margin. By hovering over the 'Accounts' link a window will appear showing all your account numbers.
